

STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES
Allocations for English Literacy/Civics Education Projects

Request: The State Board is requested to approve allocations for thirty-three English Literacy/Civics Education projects in the amount of \$1,101,700.

These federal funds provide for civics education project development and the support of the instructional activities that integrate civics education content with existing English as Second Language (ESL) programs, or are stand-alone civic participation programs. Civics education emphasizes contextualized instruction on the rights and responsibilities of citizenship, naturalization procedures, civic participation, and U.S. history and government to help students acquire the skills and knowledge to become informed parents, workers, and community members.

Method of Allocation: For the 2015-2016 program year, the System Office did not hold an open application process for funding English Literacy and Civics Education programs. Instead, continuation funding is provided to the colleges and community-based organizations which received funding in the 2014-2015 fiscal year. As part of the 2015 application process, eligible providers updated their current plan and responded to specific Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) transitional planning strategies. All thirty-three current providers submitted continuation plans.

Allocation Amount and Time Period: The total allocation is \$1,101,700 for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

Fund Source and Availability: Funding is contingent upon award from the United States Department of Education Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, Title II, Adult Education and Family Literacy Act.
