Information: The System President has approved the terminations as listed below:

Background: 1D SBCCC 400.95(b) states the following: *The college shall terminate a curriculum program when there has been no enrollment for two years; a college may request an one-year extension of a curriculum program upon justification of the potential for employment opportunities and student enrollment.*

Roanoke-Chowan Community College

Building Construction Technology (A35140)

Rationale: No enrollment for two or more years: There was a lack of student interest for the curriculum program due to the decline in construction and poor employment opportunities in the college's service area. The college will continue to monitor the construction industry for changes that can be supported by short-term training through the college's continuing education department.

Termination Semester: **Fall 2017**

Plumbing (Diploma) (D35300)

Rationale: No enrollment for two or more years: There was a lack of student interest for the curriculum program due to the decline in construction and poor employment opportunities in the college's service area. The college will continue to monitor construction and home service repair industries for changes that can be supported by short-term training through the college's continuing education department.
