Proposal for New Career and College Promise Pathways Leading to
the Associate in Fine Arts in Music (P1072C) and Associate in Fine Arts in Theatre (P1082C)

Request: The State Board is asked to approve the two following discipline specific Associate in Fine Arts (AFA) Career and College Promise (CCP) Pathways:

- Associate in Fine Arts in Music Pathway (P1072C)
- Associate in Fine Arts in Theatre Pathway (P1082C)

Strategic Plan Reference(s):

Theme: Clear and Supported Pathways for Student Progress and Success

Goal 2: Provide a continuum of education, training advising, and support to help learners make informed decisions that lead to credentials and careers.

- Objective 2.3. Increase completion of credentials for successful transition to careers and/or further education.
 - Strategy 2.3.1: Simplify and streamline processes from entry through completion/ transfer, effectively incorporating multiple on and off ramps.

Rationale: A faculty committee for both the Associate in Fine Arts in Music and Associate in Fine Arts in Theater developed Career and College Promise pathways leading to the Associate in Fine Arts in Music and Associate in Fine Arts in Theater. These new Career and College Promise Pathways will assist high school juniors and seniors who wish to begin study toward the Associate in Fine Arts Music or Associate in Fine Arts in Theater degree which align with the uniform articulation agreements for the baccalaureate of fine arts degrees in Music and Theater respectively.
