The State Board is asked to approve the following course for placement in the Combined Course Library (CCL).

**Request for New Course 1 of 4**

**Requesting College or Agency:** NC Department of Public Safety (NCDPS) / System Office

Course ID	Course Title	Recommended Hours	Program Area	Tier Designation
CJC-5033	NCDPS Pre-Basic Training	56	R20 – Criminal Justice	3

**Description:** This certification-related course is pre-basic training for identified correctional system personnel employed by the NC Department of Public Safety (NCDPS). Colleges must have prior approval from the NCDPS Office of Staff Development and Training (OSDT) for each offering of this course and must adhere to all NCDPS requirements for curriculum content, student testing, instructor qualifications, and overall program management.

**Rationale:**

The NC Department of Public Safety has requested this course to support their partnerships with selected community colleges to provide Pre-Basic Training (PBT) to help meet state training needs.

**Requesting College or Agency:** Fire and Rescue Commission/Certification Board and NC Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM)

FIP-3716	Fire Chief 101-2020 Ed	12	R30 – Fire & Rescue Services	3

**Description:** This certification-related course is designed to apprise chief officers of the various aspects and complexities surrounding the operations and organization of North Carolina Fire departments. Emphasis will be placed on ratings and inspections, NFIRS reporting, prevention and relief funds, grant programs, basic line of duty death information, various state associations, and an overview of chief officer expectations in North Carolina. This class will satisfy the 9S insurance inspection criteria as specified by the North Carolina Administrative Code. This course should be offered consistent with the most current NC Fire and Rescue Commission guidelines; contact the Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for details.

- This request for new course FIP-3716 Fire Chief 101-2020 Edition (effective for courses starting as of January 1, 2020) is to position the Common Course Library (CCL) to support the Fire and Rescue Commission's pending transition to an updated version of this course.

**Description:** This certification-related course is designed as an update to the Fire Chief 101 Course. Course content is revised on a five-year cycle so that chief officers receive the most relevant and current information available. This course should be offered consistent with the most current NC Fire and Rescue Commission guidelines; contact the Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for details.

FIP-7001	FF/TR Emergency Medical Care	12	R30 – Fire & Rescue Services	2

**Description:** This certification-related course is designed to give the candidate a basic understanding of emergency medical care procedures as well as all of the information required to meet the knowledge, skills, and abilities to satisfy the key requirements of NFPA 1001: *Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications* (2017 edition; Chapter 6) and NFPA 1006: *Standard for Technical Rescuer Professional Qualifications* (2013 edition; Chapter 4). This course should be offered consistent with the most current NC Fire and Rescue Commission guidelines; contact the Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for details.

**Rationale:**

- This request for new course FIP-7001 FF/TR Emergency Medical Care is to position the Combined Course Library (CCL) to support the Fire and Rescue Commission's pending transition to one combined Firefighter and Trench Rescue Emergency Medical Care course over the next couple of years.
