Curriculum Program Terminations Approved by the System President

Information: The State Board of the North Carolina Community College System, through delegated authority to the System President, approved the program terminations listed below:

Background: 1D SBCCC 400.6 (b) states the following: *The college shall terminate a curriculum program when there has been no enrollment for two consecutive years or if the college has not offered the program or has not had enrollment in the program within two years of the date the program was approved by the State Board of Community Colleges. A college may request a one-year extension of a curriculum program upon justification of the potential for employment opportunities and student enrollment.*

College of The Albemarle

Supply Chain Management (A25620)

Rationale: Low Enrollment. Due to low interest in the program and the industry trends of supply chain management in the college's service area, the college is terminating the program. The college is planning to continue offering supply chain management and distribution and logistics courses under the existing Business Administration (A25120) program.

Termination Semester: Fall 2021

Edgecombe Community College

School-Age Education (Certificate) (C55440)

Rationale: Low Enrollment. The program has lost enrollment due to students Choosing to enroll in other Early Childhood Program pathway options. The College has a plan to teach-out the current students in the School-Age Certificate program.

Termination Semester: Spring 2022
