



1 ~~(e) Senior citizens who are legal residents of North Carolina and who wish to enroll in an~~  
2 ~~occupational extension course, shall not be required to pay for taking the course twice. Senior~~  
3 ~~citizens who take an occupational extension course more than twice within a five year period~~  
4 ~~shall pay their cost for the course based on the amount of funds generated by a student~~  
5 ~~membership hour for occupational extension multiplied by the number of actual hours the class~~  
6 ~~is to be taught. These senior citizens shall not generate budget/FTE. The funds collected from~~  
7 ~~these senior citizens shall be used by the colleges to offer additional educational courses.~~

8 ~~(d) Students may repeat occupational extension courses more than once if the repetitions are~~  
9 ~~required for certification, licensure, or recertification. The colleges shall submit annual reports~~  
10 ~~to the State Board of Community Colleges naming the students and the certification, licensure or~~  
11 ~~recertification requirements that necessitated the repetition.~~

12 ~~(e)~~(b) Self-supporting classes shall not be reported for regular budget purposes (those classes  
13 supported by student fees or a class in which instruction is provided gratis); all recreational  
14 extension classes fall in this category.

15 ~~(f)~~(c) Occupational extension instruction shall not be offered in sheltered workshops and adult  
16 developmental activity centers (ADAP) except sheltered workshops and ADAP centers may  
17 contract with the community college to provide occupational extension courses on a  
18 self-supporting basis.

19 ~~(g)~~(d) Educational programs offered in a correctional department setting shall report full-time  
20 equivalent (FTE) student hours on the basis of contact hours.
