Curriculum Standard Revision Approved by the System President

Information: The System President has approved the curriculum standard revision listed below:

Curriculum Program: Architectural Technology (A40100)

Revision: Add newly approved ARC 116 Architectural Design Studio I, ARC 117 Architectural Design Studio II, and ARC 216 Architectural Design Studio III as additional course options to the existing course lists contained within the curriculum standard program major area.

The additional course options are designed to allow for closer program alignment with UNC Charlotte's architectural program; therefore, will be beneficial to program completers who matriculate to UNCC. Colleges wanting to retain their current program of study may continue to do so without change.

Background: 1D SBCCC 400.9 (b) states:

A revision of an existing curriculum standard shall:

- (1) Have written concurrence by two-thirds of colleges approved to offer the curriculum program; and*
- (2) Be in alignment with criteria outlined in 1D SBCCC 400.10(e).*
- (3) The President of the North Carolina Community College System shall have the authority to approve or deny the revision of an existing curriculum standard. If only two colleges are approved to offer the curriculum, and written concurrence is not obtained from both colleges, the State Board of Community Colleges shall have the authority to approve or deny the revision to the existing curriculum standard.*

Information: The System President has approved the curriculum standard revision listed below:

Curriculum Program: Aerostructure Manufacturing Technology (A50450)

Revision:

- Revise curriculum title from Aerostructure Manufacturing Technology and Repair to Aerostructure Manufacturing Technology.
- Revise Curriculum Description.
- Remove structures course list from the Required Subject Area.
- Remove MEC 128 Machining Processes and ASM 210 Computer Aided 3D Appl from the core of the program standard.
- Add AET, DFT, EHS, LOG, OMT, and PMT prefixes to the Other Major Hours category.

Rationale: The submitting college suggests that the curriculum title change will more accurately reflect program content which is more focused on the manufacturing aspect of the aviation industry. The revision to the curriculum description, core courses, and additional prefixes will allow the college to offer appropriate coursework that better aligns with varying aviation manufacturing industry employee skill requirements. Guilford Technical Community College is the only college approved to offer the program.
