Curriculum Program Terminations Approved by the System President

Information: The State Board of the North Carolina Community College System, through delegated authority to the System President, approved the program terminations listed below:

Background: 1D SBCCC 400.6 (b) states the following: *The college shall terminate a curriculum program when there has been no enrollment for two consecutive years or if the college has not offered the program or has not had enrollment in the program within two years of the date the program was approved by the State Board of Community Colleges. A college may request a one year extension of a curriculum program upon justification of the potential for employment opportunities and student enrollment.*

Catawba Valley Community College

Emergency Medical Science (D45910)

Health Science: Therapeutic and Diagnostic Services program major.

Rationale: No Enrollment. Students interested in this field are registering for the continuing education classes or other degree options.

Termination Semester: **Fall 2021**

College of The Albemarle

Architectural Technology (A40100)

Rationale: No Enrollment. There has been a lack of student interest as well as limited career opportunities for students in the program which has resulted in no enrollment. Design courses will still be made available under the college's Computer-Aided Drafting Technology program.

Termination Semester: **Fall 2021**

College of The Albemarle

Sustainability Technologies (A40370)

Rationale: No Enrollment. There has been a lack of student interest as well as limited career opportunities for students in the sustainability program which has resulted in no enrollment. Energy efficiency courses are embedded within specific programs where appropriate.

Termination Semester: **Fall 2021**

Fayetteville Technical Community College

Electronics Engineering Technology (A40200)

Rationale: Low Enrollment. There has been a lack of student interest as well as limited career opportunities for students in the program which has resulted in low enrollment. Students will continue to be served by the college's electrical and industrial systems programs.

Termination Semester: **Spring 2022**

Gaston College

Nutrition and Dietetics Technician (A45860)

Rationale: Low enrollment. Declining enrollment in this program over the last four years. Students interested in this field are registering for the continuing education classes.

Termination Semester: Spring 2021

Gaston College

Therapeutic Massage (A45750)

Rationale: Low enrollment. Declining enrollment in this program over the last four years. Students interested in this field are registering for the continuing education classes.

Termination Semester: Spring 2021

Robeson Community College

School-Age Care (Certificate) (C55450)

Rationale: No Enrollment. The program has lost enrollment due to the changes in requirements for employment for Before/After School personnel in the public school system. Requirements have been reduced to a minimum of one course, EDU 119 Introduction to Early Childhood Education. Current students in the School-Age Certificate program have opted to transfer to one of the other three Early Childhood Certificate options for completion.

Termination Semester: Spring 2021

Wake Technical Community College

Fire Protection Technology (A55240)

Rationale: Low enrollment. The college's Fire Protection Technology Advisory Committee confirmed that the college's new Public Safety Administration (A55460) degree program will be a viable alternative for fire-service students while also providing career advancement options for other public safety professionals.
