Descriptions

This course is designed for remediation to assist nursing students upon completion of the Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) or Licensed Practical Nursing (LPN) programs. The course targets nursing students who in the final semester of the nursing program are deficient in didactic content, but at the point of deficiency have mastered all other benchmarks for success in the nursing program. Upon successful completion, the student will demonstrate mastery in the identified areas of content deficiency and be eligible to sit for NCLEX.

Rationale:

This course is requested to facilitate a workforce opportunity for nursing students, who in their final semester are deficient in didactic content and become ineligible to sit for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX). Without an opportunity to address these deficiencies students may wait multiple semesters before they have an opportunity to re-enter a curriculum track and complete the final semester. This places a financial burden on the student, delays them from entering the workforce as a licensed professional, and often these students are not successful upon return due to the time lapse between training.

A pilot program of this course was offered at Edgecombe CC and 100% of the students involved completed the Workforce Continuing Education course and all successfully passed the NCLEX.
