BAR-3100	Registered Barber	574	T75-Service	2

Rationale:

- This course is designed to provide the necessary skills to work to meet the instructional requirements to become a registered barber as established by the NC Board of Barber Examiners. Schools must be approved by the NC Board of Barber Examiners to provide training (Reference: G.S. 86A-1)

ICV 3111	Cardiovascular Technician/Monitor	112	L30 Health	2

Rationale:

- This course is designed and approved to prepare the student to become a certified EKG (ECG) Technician/Monitor.

FIP-3715	Fire Chief 101 Upgrade	3	R30 Fire & Rescue Services	3

Rationale:

- Per NC Administrative Code, all NC Fire Chiefs are required to complete a class on the basic management of fire operations and records a minimum of every five years. The Commission has now approved a course update that allows those who have already completed the Chief 101 course to take the Chief upgrade course every five years to meet this mandate. (Reference: 11 NCAC 05A .0505 Drills and Meeting Requirements)

Request #4 of 5 (Modification)

CJC-3941	Detention Officer Cert	From 162 to 172	R20-Criminal Justice	2

Rationale:

- This is a request to increase the recommended hours to 172 to align with an increase in hours mandated by the Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards Commission. This certification-related Detention Officer Certification Course (DOCC) is offered under guidelines and requirements set forth by the North Carolina Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards Commission. Properly certified State instructors are used in all topic areas. Trainees must successfully pass the State administered exam as well as demonstrate competency in all skill areas in order to be eligible for certification as a detention officer. Lecture, demonstrations and practical exercises are primary methods of instruction. Contact the NC Department of Justice for course standards.

Request #5 of 5 (Modification to Tier Designation)

FUR-3300	Furniture Technology	336	P35-Industrial/ Manufacturing	Move from Tier 3 to Tier 2

Rationale:

- This training program supports the specific industry training needs within the furniture technology sector. The program curriculum focuses on the training demands from major industry partners in the western region of NC and is closely modeled after the national model established by the National Association of Manufacturers (NAM). Additional validation of training rigor is documented through the acceptance of the training program within the NC Department of Commerce – Apprentice and Training Bureau as a registered pre-apprenticeship program.
