

STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES
Curriculum Program Terminations As Approved by the System President

Information: The State Board of the North Carolina Community College System, through delegated authority to the System President, approved the program terminations listed below:

Background: 1D SBCCC 400.6 (b) states the following: *The college shall terminate a curriculum program when there has been no enrollment for two consecutive years or if the college has not offered the program or has not had enrollment in the program within two years of the date the program was approved by the State Board of Community Colleges. A college may request a one year extension of a curriculum program upon justification of the potential for employment opportunities and student enrollment.*

Blue Ridge Community College

Alternative Transportation Technology (Diploma) (D60420)

Rationale: Low Enrollment. Student lack of interest, limited numbers of these vehicles in the college's service area, and loss of tax credits for these vehicles, were contributing factors to the program's low enrollment. Training will be moved to the college's Workforce Continue Education program area as demand for it is warranted.

Termination Semester: **Spring 2022**

College of The Albemarle

Cosmetology Instructor (Certificate) (C55160)

Rationale: Rationale: No Enrollment. Due to lack of student interest and lack of job opportunities for cosmetology instructors in the college service area, the courses have not had adequate enrollment to continue.

Termination Semester: **Fall 2022**

College of The Albemarle

Healthcare Technology (Certificate) (C45350)

Rationale: No enrollment. Local hospitals and employers are using in-house employer training coupled with continuing education courses for their employees and no longer need this certificate.

Termination Semester: **Fall 2022**

Wake Technical Community College

Heavy Equipment Operation, Management, and Service (A35340)

Rationale: Low Enrollment. The program saw a decline in enrollment over the past several years as more companies offered on-the-job training opportunities for heavy equipment operators. Training equipment will be moved to into the college's diesel and heavy equipment program area.
