UAS-3111	Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems	24	V20 -Aircraft Systems	3

Description:

This course prepares learners for small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (sUAS)/Drone flight certification. Topics include flight theory, flight operations, and flight training utilizing the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Remote Pilot – Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems Study Guide, North Carolina Unmanned Aircraft Systems Operator Permit Knowledge Test Study Guide, and North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) Division of Aviation UAS flight standards & best practices. Learners will gain an introduction to commercial, government, and recreational drone applications. Coursework will highlight topics such as regulations, weather, airspace, human factors, and sUAS performance. Upon completion, students will be prepared to sit for the FAA Part 107 Remote Pilot Knowledge Test and NCDOT UAS Operator Permit. This course must be taught utilizing the NC Department of Transportation Division of Aviation approved curriculum.

Rationale:

This request is generated from NCDOT Division of Aviation with member institution support.

Session Law 2014-100, granted the Division of Aviation the responsibility to implement testing and permitting systems for UAS operations in North Carolina.

Description:

The primary goal of this course is to increase attendee's ability to successfully pass the Landscape Contractors' Licensing Exam while gaining information that will enhance their level of professionalism in the landscaping industry. Course content will include: Landscape Design & Construction, Business Concepts, Landscape Contractor Laws, and Landscape Math & Plan Reading Concepts. Course objectives are designed to prepare individuals to take the NC Landscape Contractors' Licensing exam as well as providing an opportunity to enhance individual understanding of these key components. The class may also be utilized by existing landscape contractors to meet continuing education requirements.

Rationale:

Session Laws 2015-103, s. 3(a) created the NC Landscape Contractors' Licensing Board charged with regulating the licensure of applicants for individuals defined as Landscape Contractors under the provisions of G.S. Chapter 89D.

The NC Landscape Contractors' Licensing Board has collaborated with NC State University for the development of the syllabus material to support the training required to successfully pass the state licensing exam.
