EDT-3100	Intraoperative Neuro-Monitoring	300	L30-Health	1B

Rationale:

- This is a request from Pamlico CC. The college provided an in-depth overview of the program to include local market information to support the need for training and the availability of jobs.
- This request provides a systematic pathway with both didactic and clinical training for individuals preparing for the certification examination for Neurophysiologic Intraoperative Monitoring (CNIM) through the American Board of Registration of Electroencephalographic and Evoked Potential Technologists (ABRET).
- The course provides an advanced understanding of intraoperative neurophysiological monitoring (IONM) and Evoked Potentials (EP) used in neurological diagnosis. Topics include foundations of evoked potentials, operating room monitoring, special monitoring techniques and equipment, anesthesia types and usage, electrical safety, infectious control and critical conditions requiring communication and interventions. Additionally, students will participate in a clinical rotation at a facility that provides IONM and EP testing.
- All students entering this continuing education course must have some prerequisite course work in an Electroneurodiagnostic Technology program and/or an Associate's degree and/or credential in one of the following: R.EEGT, R. EPT, R.PSGT, or R.NCST.
