The System President has approved the termination(s) as listed below.

- **Piedmont Community College**
Business Administration/Electronic Commerce (A2512I)
Rationale: Low Enrollment: There are insufficient employment opportunities for individuals graduating from this program in the college's service area. Students enrolled in the Business Administration/Electronic Commerce (A2512I) program will be given the opportunity to complete their degree under the existing program or transfer to the Business Administration/International Business (A2512D) program.
Termination Semester: Fall 2013
- **Piedmont Community College**
Facility Maintenance Technology (A50190)
Rationale: Low Enrollment: There has been a decline in the enrollment in the Facility Maintenance program over the past three years due to a depressed job market.
Termination Semester: Fall 2013
- **Piedmont Community College**
School Age Education (A55440)
Rationale: Low Enrollment: The enrollment in the School Age Education program has steadily declined over the past five years due to limited teacher assistant positions.
Termination Semester: Fall 2013
- **Robeson Community College**
Lateral Entry (Certificate) (C55430)
Rationale: Low Enrollment: Public school teachers have other options to get credit for the coursework that is required to be a lateral entry teacher, which are less expensive and shorter in duration.
Termination Semester: Spring 2014
