Curriculum Program Terminations  
As Approved by the System President

The System President has approved the termination(s) as listed below.

- Craven Community College  
Sustainable Agriculture (A15410)  
**Rationale:** Craven Community College submitted an application for this program in Spring 2012 and received approval for implementation in Fall 2012. Additional research and a more in-depth trend analysis suggest that it would not be prudent to begin an AAS program in Sustainable Agriculture at Craven at this time. The lack of viable employment opportunities and a weak prognosis for attracting students from the region to participate also contributed to the decision to terminate the program.  
**Termination Semester: Spring 2013**
- Fayetteville Technical Community College  
Criminal Justice Technology/Financial Crime/Computer Fraud (A5518B)  
**Rationale:** There are not enough employment opportunities within the college's service area for individuals possessing the level of financial crime or computer fraud skills associated with the program concentration. This has resulted in low interest as well as low enrollment in this program.  
**Termination Semester: Fall 2013**
- Pitt Community College  
Information Systems Security (A25270)  
**Rationale:** This program has not been offered recently due to the current economic trends in the college's service area. Information Systems Security courses and concepts are currently offered as a certificate under the Networking Technology (A25340) program.  
**Termination Semester: Fall 2013**
- Rowan-Cabarrus Community College  
Manicuring Instructor (C55380)  
**Rationale:** There are not many positions for Manicuring Instructors because Cosmetology Instructors can teach Manicuring.  
**Termination Semester: Fall 2013**
