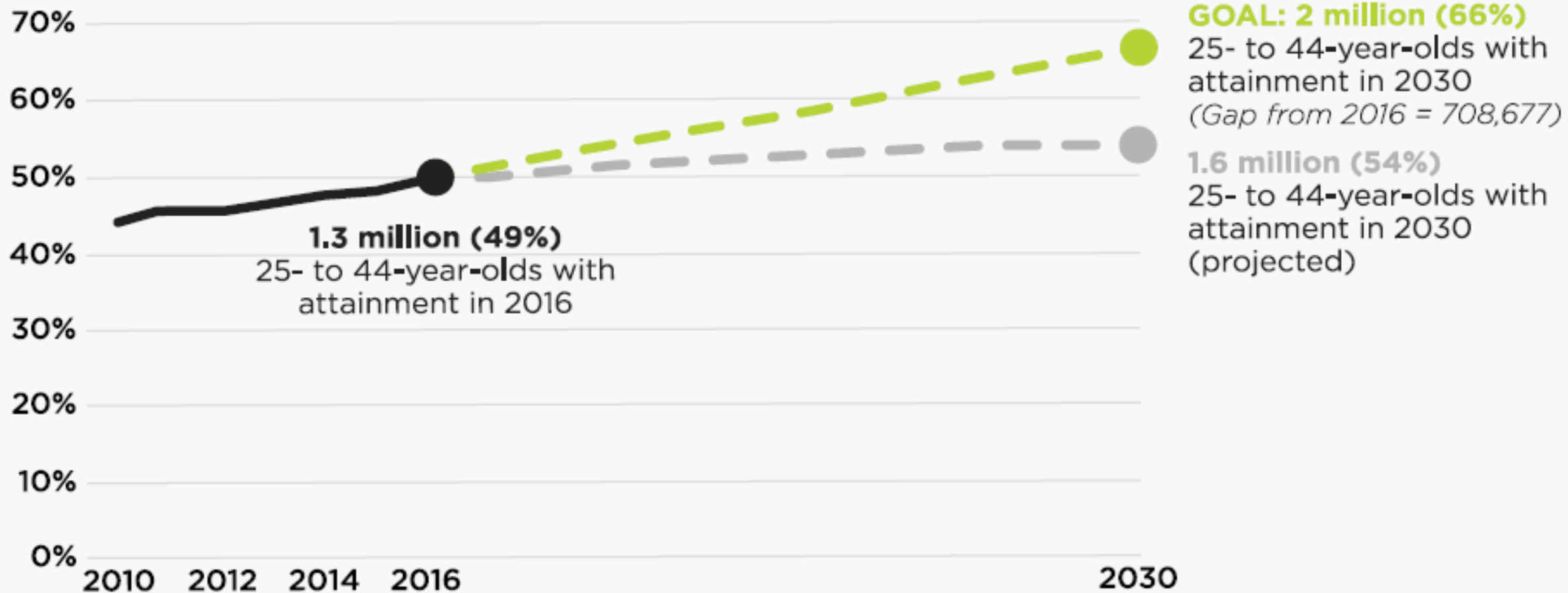

# MyFutureNC Goal

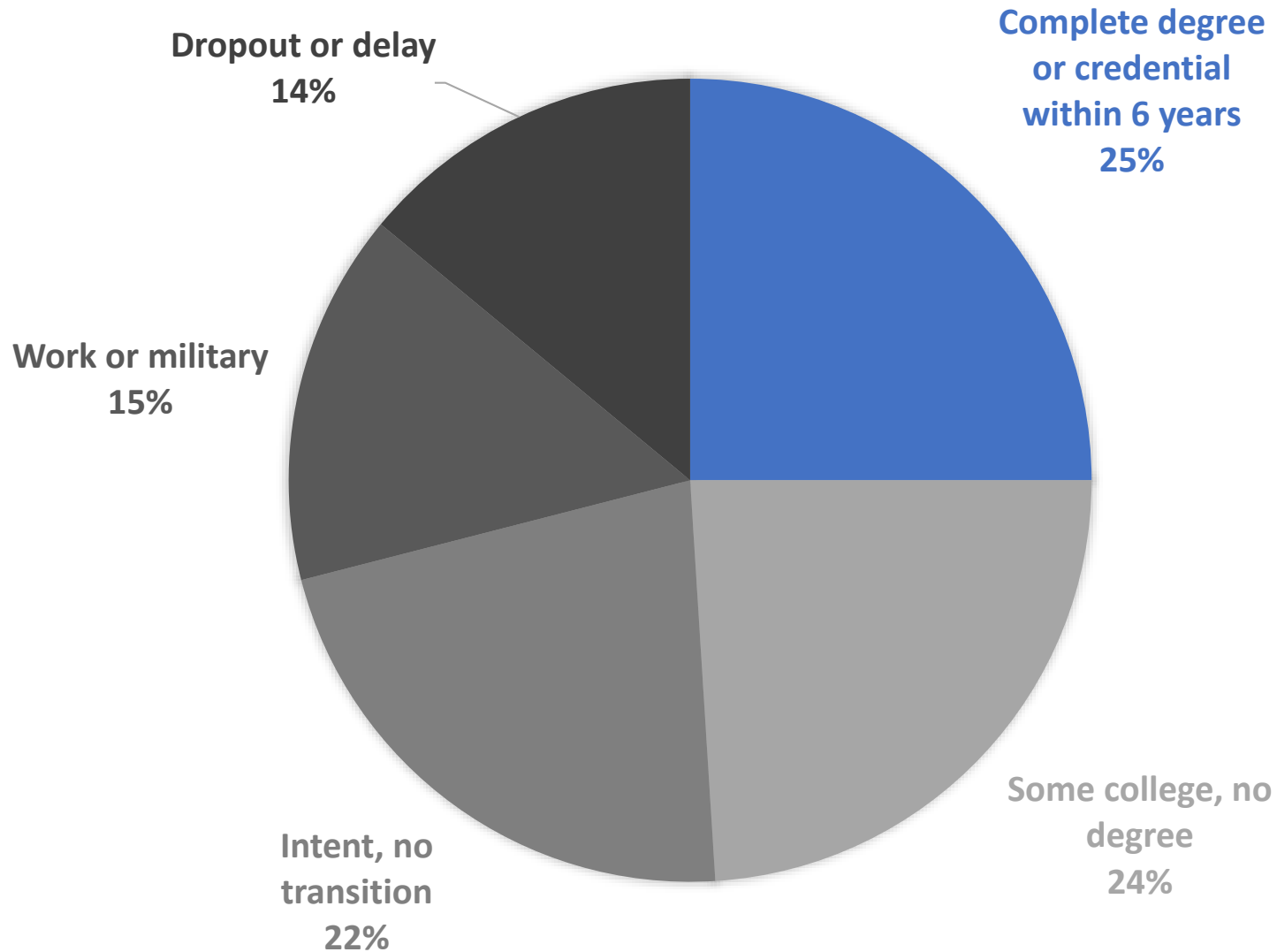
**By 2030, 2 million North Carolinians, ages 25-44, will have a high-quality degree or credential.**

- **Today, only 49 percent of North Carolinians have a postsecondary degree or credential**
- **Two-thirds of jobs in North Carolina will require that level by 2020**

# The attainment goal: Two-thirds with degrees/credentials by 2030

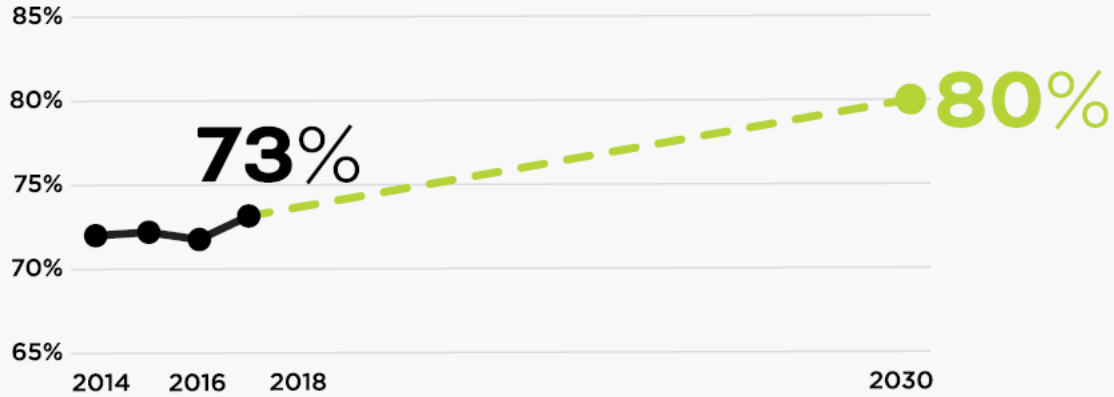


# North Carolina's leaky education pipeline

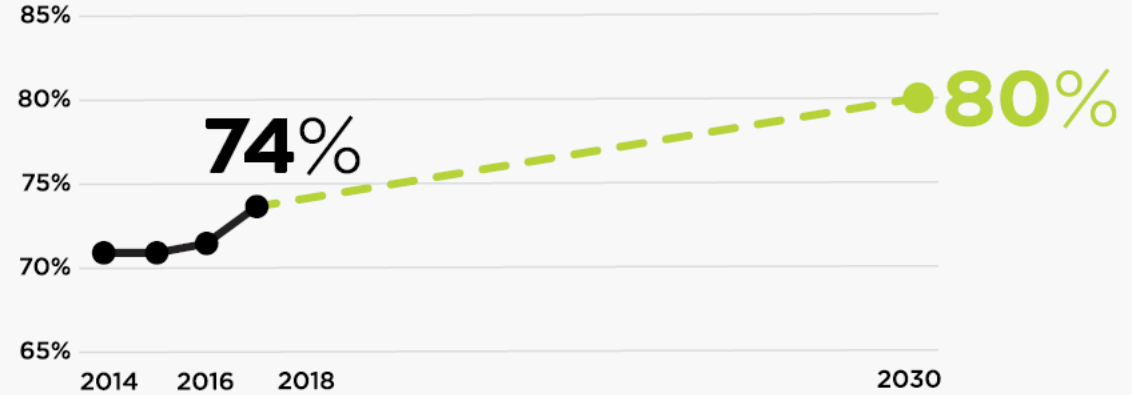


# Target completion rates for two-year and four-year institutions

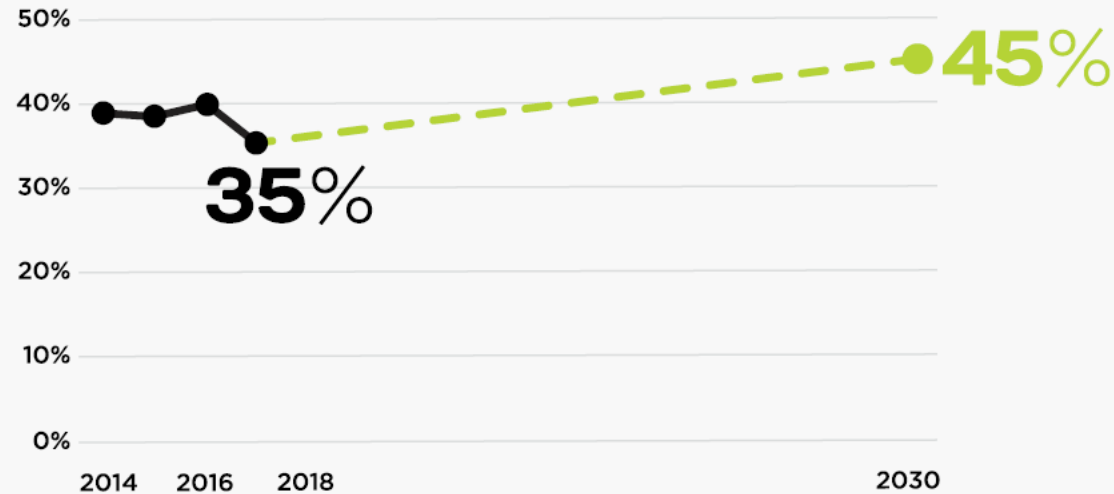
PRIVATE 4-YEAR TOTAL COMPLETION RATE



PUBLIC 4-YEAR TOTAL COMPLETION RATE

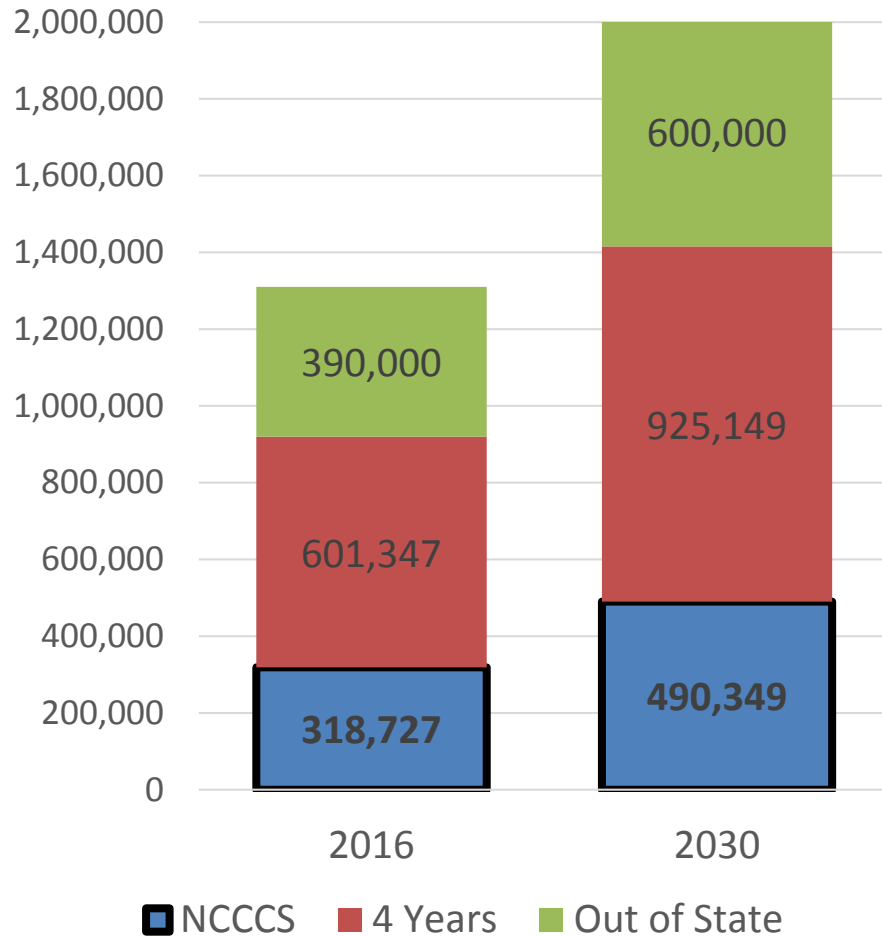


PUBLIC 2-YEAR TOTAL COMPLETION RATE

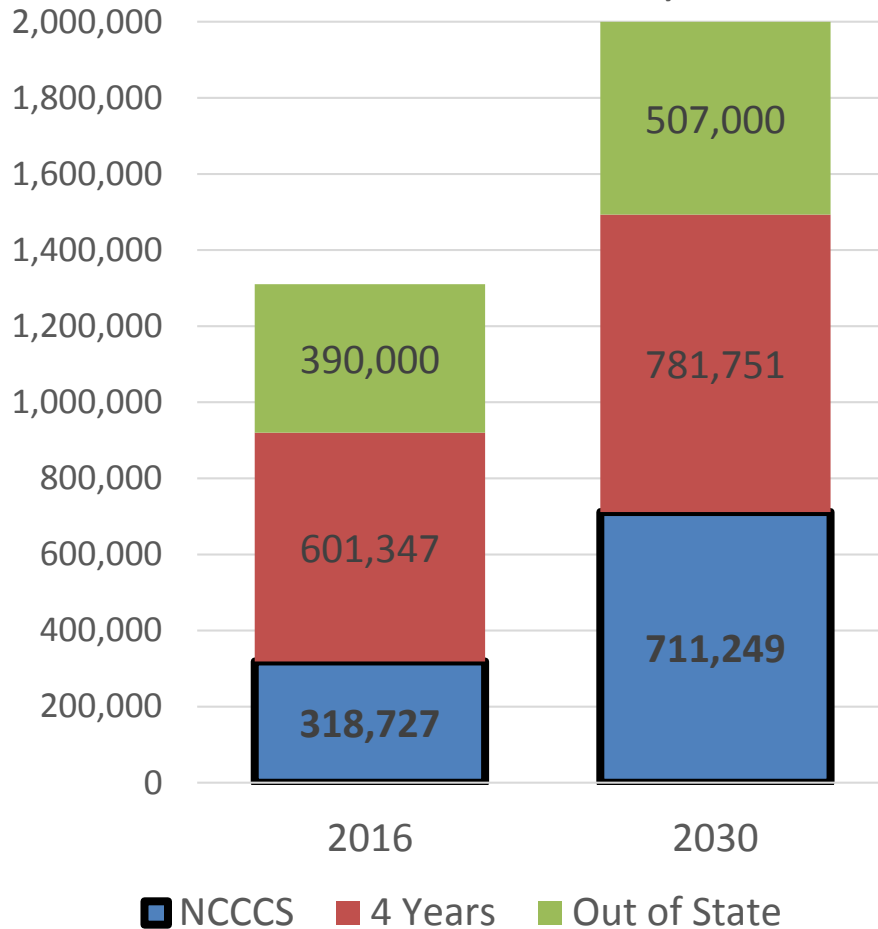


# Expectations to meet state goal by 2030

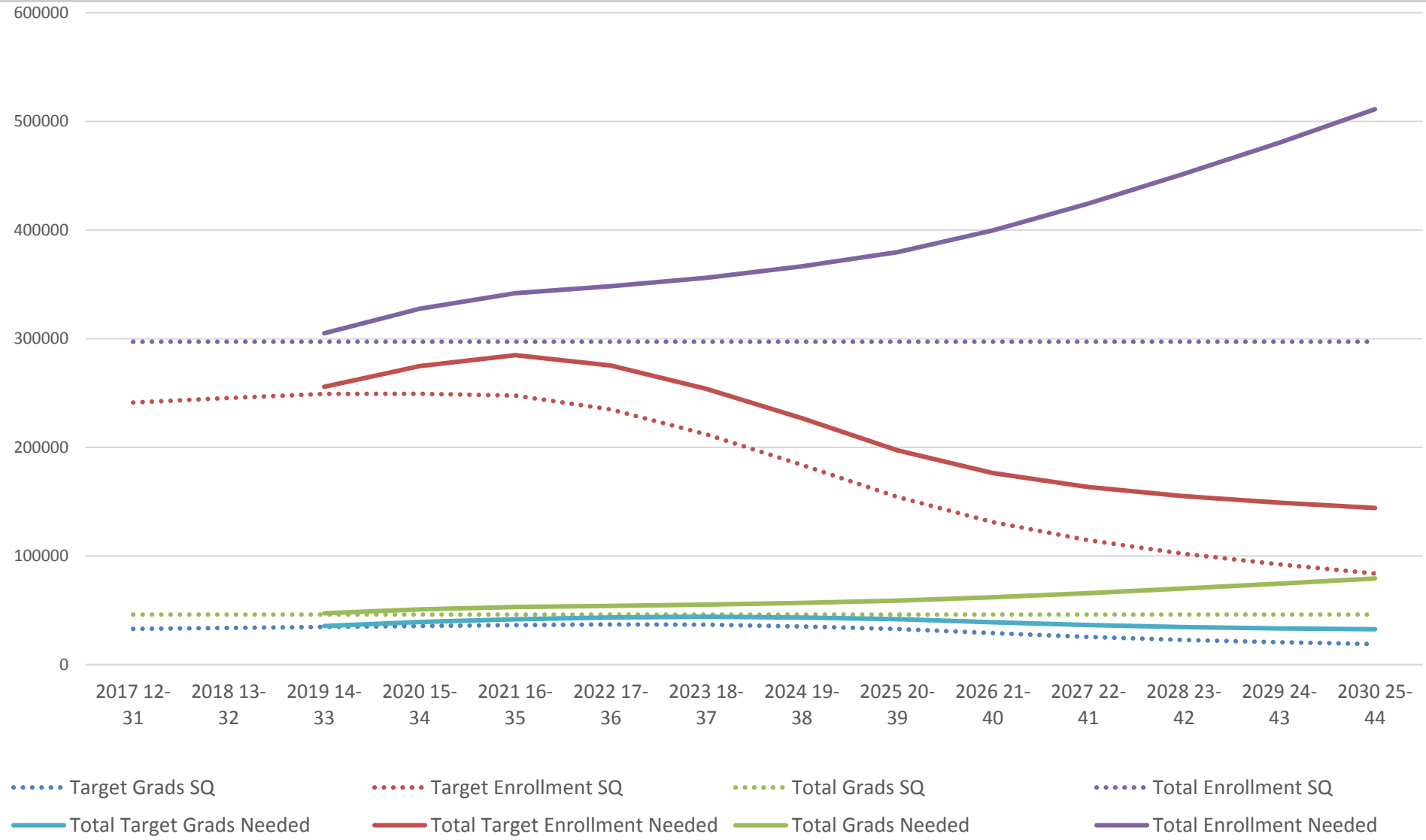
If All Sectors Increased by 53%
